
### Examples of demands in the EU Legislation

- Specific demands for **recycled content** in products –from "post consumer" waste (cars, packaging, batteries)
- Lifetime extend like "Right to repair" (eco-design-directive)
- Design circular easily dismantled (cars, batteries and packaging)
- Treat better

Recover more and better-quality raw materials through stricter definition of recycling, landfill restrictions High quality ("closed loop") recycling and substituting virgin materials (cars and packaging)



### The circular recycling principle


#### The following applies to the circular recycling principle:

- Recycled materials can be used in the packaging, and the material can be used as recycled material in the same type of packaging.
- It must be possible to sort the packaging correctly.
- When it is recycled, the packaging must not contaminate the quality of other recycled materials with non-intended added substances (NIAS).
